Computer Internet stations are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Users are required to sign in at the library's front desk. Time is limited to 45 minutes if others are waiting.

Parents of children under the age of 18 years must assume complete responsibility for their child's use of the computer Internet stations.

Users should be aware that the Internet and its available resources may contain controversial or incorrect information. The Library is not responsible for censoring access to Internet materials, validating Internet information, or for protecting users from offensive matter.

Computer Internet stations should be used in a manner similar to other information resources at the Richmond Public Library. Patrons who use the library's computers for illegal or unethical purposes will lose computer privileges and may have their library privileges revoked.

The Richmond Public Library assumes no responsibility for any damages, direct or indirect, that may arise from patrons using the computer Internet stations.
